



Key Instant Recall Facts

EYFS- Summer 2

I can use physical representations to add and subtract.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

E.g.

First they have 2 cars.

Then they add 1 car.

Now they have 3 cars.

Children are to 'count on' to work this out
(1, 2, 3)

First they have 7 cars.

Then they take 2 away.

Now they have 5 cars.

Children are to 'count back' to work this out
(7, 6, 5)
