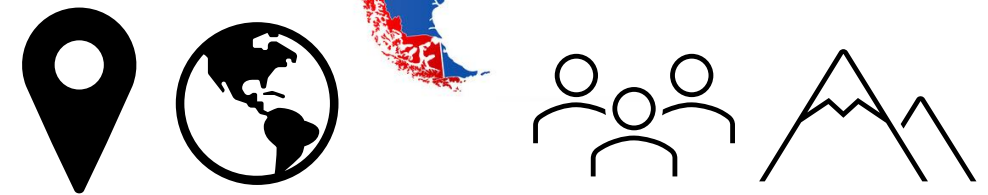

Key Vocabulary

Trade	The action of buying and selling goods and services.
Location	A particular place or position.
Economics	Information about the production, consumption and transfer of wealth including the condition of a region or group's material prosperity (wealth).
Climate	The weather conditions in an area in general or over a long period of time.
Import	Bring goods or services into a country from abroad for sale.
Export	Send goods or services to another country for sale.
Culture	The ideas, customs and social behaviours of a particular people or society.
Temperate	A climate zone with mild temperatures.
Sub-tropical	Climate zones bordering on the tropics that are slightly cooler than tropical regions.
