

The Friends of Bleak Hill are hoping to run the annual Summer Gala on **Friday 5th July (3.30 – 6pm approx)**. This is our main fundraising event of the school year and is a chance for the whole school community to celebrate and have a fun time together whilst raising much needed funds for the school. Unfortunately, due to the small number of regular FOBH members (5) we are not going to be able to run this event unless we get support from parents/carers.

If you are not able to help but know any grandparents or other family members that would be able to help, or if you want to form a group of parents that will run a stall together in time slots etc please contact us with your details.



As a school with a limited budget (due to the way school funding is allocated) these fundraising events are essential to make sure the children at Bleak Hill have the facilities and enrichment opportunities other schools, with larger budgets, can fund. So, if you are unable to help at the gala but would be able to donate a prize (voucher for beauty treatment, car/ boiler service, meal for two etc...) or make a cash donation to help with fundraising this would also be a tremendous help. We are currently raising funds for a Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) for the children to use during break times and P.E. lessons. This will cost in the region of £80,000 and school will need to raise at least half of this to secure 'match funding'. The children have told us that they want to be able to play football and other activities at break time and as the fields around school do not have good drainage and can become very wet and muddy it would give the children a safe, dry area to use.

FOBH are incredibly grateful for all the support you have shown us so far this year and just hope you are able to offer help to make sure this much-loved event can go ahead and raise funds for our children.
