As we reflect on another eventful week at Bleak Hill Primary School, I am pleased to share with you the range of enriching experiences our children and parents this week, demonstrating our commitment to holistic education and community involvement.

We commenced the week with our SEND Coffee Afternoon, and I extend my thanks to all parents and carers who attended. Your participation is invaluable, and we eagerly anticipate your attendance at future sessions, fostering a collaborative approach to supporting our children's diverse needs.

Tuesday saw our school unite in observance of World Religion Day, with a whole-school focus on cultivating tolerance for other faiths. This initiative aligns with our ethos of nurturing empathetic, globally-aware citizens who appreciate the rich diversity of beliefs in our community.

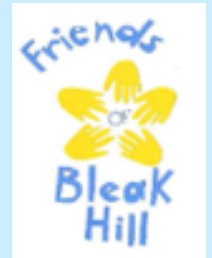
