Y3—Penny (3S) - Creative

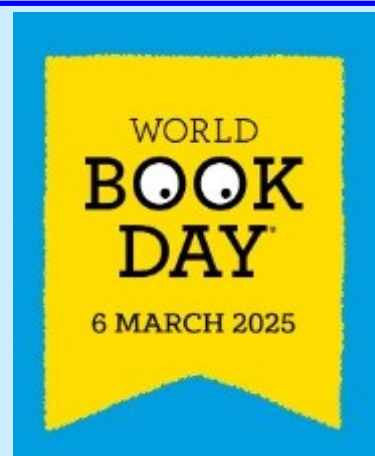

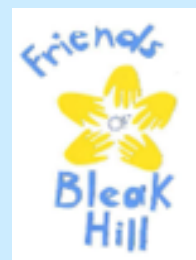
