Or even a sponsored read-a-thon, silence, sleepover or even a month without sweets! Whatever you want!

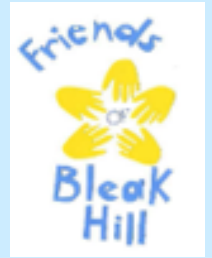
